It's all down to the mix: the AllRounder combines the performance, flexibility and simple operation of a top-class lawn tractor with the extreme manoeuvrability of a zero-turn mower – on flat terrain as well as on hillsides. This is what makes it so unique.

The fact is: very few of us can call an obstacle-free, English-style lawn our own; the lawn in our garden is usually more like a slalom course full of trees and shrubs which are tricky to deal with. Happy the man who has the AllRounder ready at hand.

Cub Cadet AllRounder: more manoeuvrability + more convenience = more leisure time

This is the equation for the AllRounder. Apart from being a multitalent with impressive technology it is essentially a lawn tractor which saves the user time. The performance parameters speak for themselves: the transmission is low-maintenance and robust and provides gradual and smooth speed control when driving forward and in reverse. No need to operate the clutch or change gear – both hands remain on the wheel.

The AllRounder even masters hillsides and uneven terrain effortlessly and safely. This is down to the powerful two-cylinder Kohler command engine with overhead valves. The mowing deck with three-blade technology has an cutting width of 127 cm, can easily be attached and removed without tools thanks to its quick-change system and is equipped with deck wash nozzles to make it easy to clean when mowing is finished. Furthermore, the floating deck is guided by a special roller and wheels which adapt to the contours of the terrain. This prevents the lawn from being scalped and ensures an even cut. The wide wheel base ensures outstanding stability on hillsides, broad tyres provide excellent traction.

But wait for this: the patented steering and transmission system which makes it a world first allows it to turn on the spot. This creates a real time saving on large lawns with lots of trees and shrubs. For a start, the tractor can be driven much more accurately and closer to such "obstacles" and what's more, there is no need to go over difficult parts with a push mower. The list of special features continues with a device called "RevTek" which allows for safe mowing in reverse. The whole package is rounded off with the mulching kit which is included as standard.

AllRounder convenience for the most demanding gardening lovers

The AllRounder is the ideal lawn care equipment for gardening lovers with professional requirements. The development engineers at Cub Cadet have paid particular attention to a simple method of operation. Each operating control is ergonomically thought through and arranged. The mowing deck can be engaged electromechanically, for example. The user friendliness is also evident in the design of the comfortable seat with high backrest and lever-adjustment to suit the height of the user. It manifests itself in the three-spoke design of the steering wheel which always provides an unobstructed view of the displays. And it is proven not least with the layout of the pedals and levers, the step-through frame and more extras such as a twelve-volt plug for connecting accessories.

Performance which sets the standards at the top level, quality which is tangible in every operating control, comfort which turns gardening into relaxed enjoyment even for the most demanding user – the meaning of “premium” as far as “lawn care” is concerned is impressively demonstrated by the Cub Cadet AllRounder.
